Discussion continues around the potential installation of protective matting on the village greens to address parking issues and minimise damage. Replacement options and quotations are to be sought for the platform Roundabout at the Play Area, along with safety surfacing underneath the flat seat swings. This will remove the need to refill worn areas and provide a safe and even surface.
